

## 2024 Fall Free Trash Day BuRRT and Caja del Rio Landfill Saturday, September 21

The Santa Fe Solid Waste Management Agency is hosting Fall Free Trash Day for **City of Santa Fe and Santa Fe County residents** on Saturday, September 21, from 7 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Buckman Road Recycling and Transfer Station (BuRRT) and the Caja del Rio Landfill.

The Agency expects a large turnout for this popular event, so be prepared for a longer wait time than normal. Residents needing assistance with unloading should bring help with them.

Residents must also observe the following:

- All loads must be secured and covered with a tarp.
- All non-acceptable items will be subject to tipping fees.
- Loads that arrive in commercial vehicles or trailers will be subject to tipping fees for commercial/business waste.

To avoid long wait times, the Agency encourages recyclers to come on another day or to use the City recycling drop-off centers at 2950 Agua Fria or 4009 Lucia Lane.

## Acceptable items:

Garbage, rubbish, unwanted materials
Bulky items – appliances, furniture, mattresses
Residential building materials, carpet, tiles, concrete, bricks, metals

## Non-acceptable items:

Electronic Waste – Free E-Waste Days are the first Saturday of every month from February to November.

Household Hazardous Waste – Free HHW Days are the first Saturday of every month from February to November.

Tires – Free Tire Days are the first full weekend of every month.

Green Waste – Free Green Waste Days are the first full weekend every month from March to October.

The Santa Fe County convenience centers are <u>not</u> part of the free trash day. Residents will be charged the appropriate punches on their punch card.
